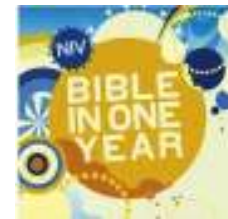
Let's not settle for a hamburger, fries and coke — when the Lord has a delicious, heavenly feast prepared for us!
