The Principle of Dedication: Commit Your Body to God

Therefore, I urge you brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your spiritual act of worship.” Romans 12:1

We all want to improve our lives. Every year we spend millions of pounds on products, books and seminars that we think will make our lives better. Sadly, most of them don't work or they only produce short-term results.

The only thing that can guarantee true transformation in your life is found in God's Word. The principle of dedication is this - commit your body to God. Any change in any area of your life begins with your physical body. Why? Because your body affects your behaviour, and every change in your life requires energy.

If you want to change, you have to make the choice. That is why the Apostle Paul tells us in Romans 12:1 to “offer your bodies.” It has to be your choice. If you don't choose to change, you are not going to change.

Here are three practical ways to offer your body to God as an act of worship:

- Cleanse your body.** I'm not talking about taking a bath. I'm talking about detoxing it. “Let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates the body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God” (2 Corinthians 7:1 NIV). The way you contaminate your body is by what you eat or drink, and the way you contaminate your spirit is by what you see or hear.
- Care for your body.** “No one hates his own body, but lovingly cares for it just as Christ cares for his body, which is the church” (Ephesians 5:29 LB). God expects you to take care of your body by keeping it in good shape, getting enough rest, and eating the right foods for good nutrition.
- Control your body.** “Each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honourable” (1 Thessalonians 4:4 NIV). This means you tell your body what to do; it doesn't tell you what to do. Controlling your body also means keeping it in good shape: “I discipline my body like an athlete, training it to do what it should do” (1 Corinthians 9:27).

Recipe for "Impossible pie (from Marion) for CAP friends and others!

Looks impossible in mixing bowl but when cooked has a sponge base and top with a custard filling

Put in large bowl :- 4 eggs, 4oz marg, 7.5oz sugar, 2oz flour (wholemeal SR is nice)

2 cups milk, 1 cup desiccated coconut, 1 teaspoon vanilla

(please note amendment from original recipe printed last week)

Mix with electric beater or by hand. Put in greased 10 inch dish and cook for up to an hour at Gas mark 4 or 180 degrees C.
