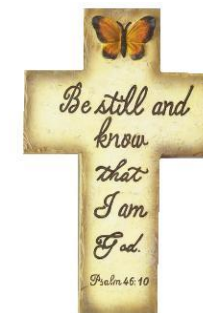

(Exodus 14:14, NIV)
